THE CANADIAN BRASS SOLO CONTEST

Using a free SmartMusic trial subscription, contestants play along with Albinoni's Adagio, playing any one of the monophonic instruments supported by the software. Voice, and polyphonic instruments including guitar and keyboards and not permitted. SmartMusic will record each performance. Contestants can record as many takes as they like and choose the best one to submit. The final winners will be selected based on the quality of his or her musical performance, as determined by MakeMusic and the Canadian Brass.

ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to legal residents of the US and Canada where not prohibited by law, who are between thirteen (13) years of age and eighteen (18) years of age on October 1, 2018, who have internet access, and have a valid e-mail account.
