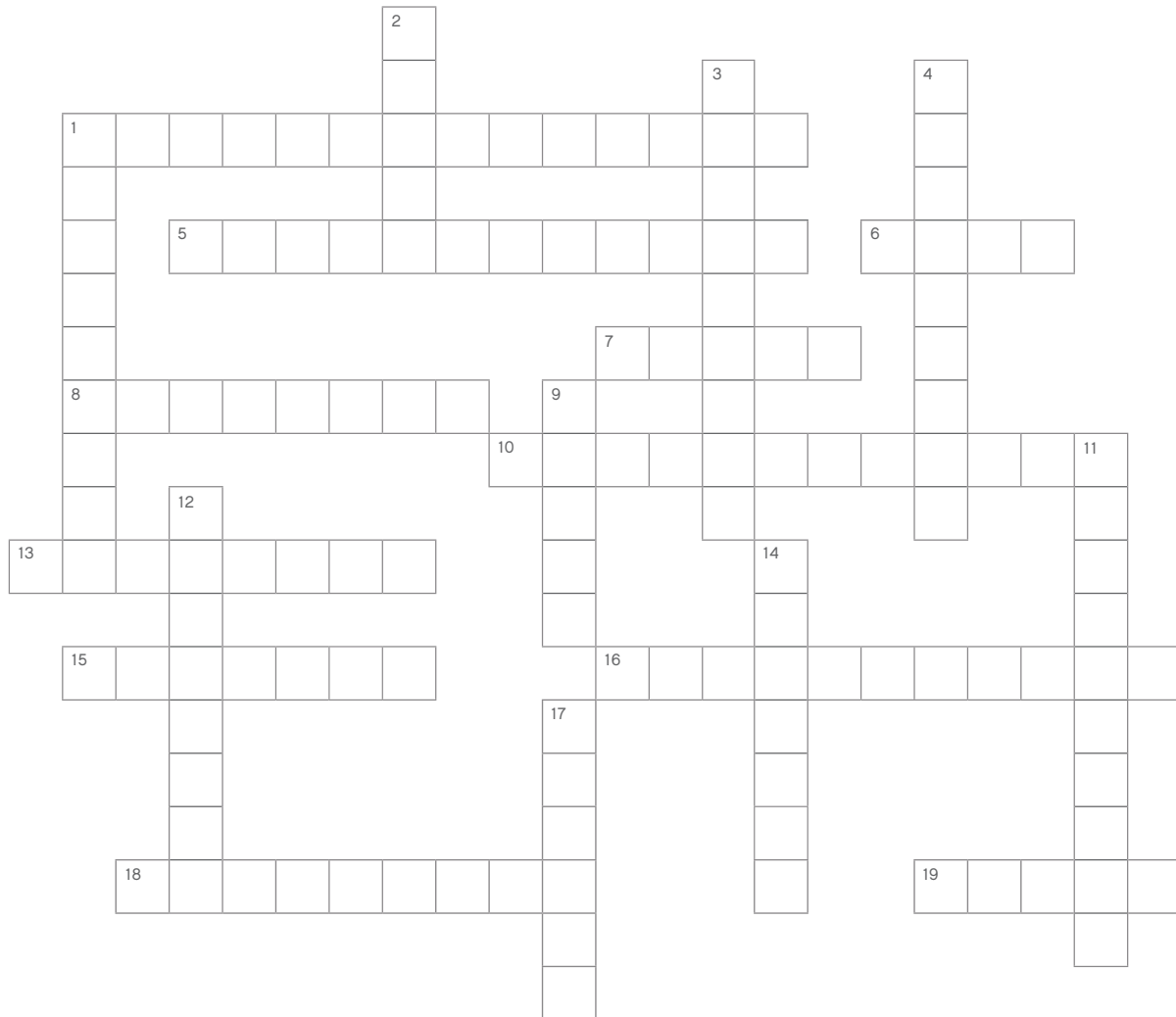


# Back to Music

## Crossword Puzzle



### ACROSS

1. The clockwise arrangement of successive keys arranged in order of ascending fifths.
5. A natural minor scale with the sixth and seventh degrees raised while ascending, and the sixth and seventh degrees lowered while descending.
6. The symbol  $\flat$  that indicates a note to be lowered one half step.
7. The symbol  $\sharp$  that indicates to raise a pitch by one half step.
8. Any group of musicians performing together.
10. The group of sharps or flats that appears at the beginning of a staff which indicates the key of a piece of music.
13. The fifth degree of a major or minor scale.
15. The symbol  $\natural$  that indicates a note is neither sharp nor flat.
16. A note that is half the length of a half note.
18. Without accompaniment.
19. Symbols that are used to indicate silence.

### DOWN

1. Gradually becoming louder.
2. Three or more tones sounded simultaneously. (*Hint: two tones are usually referred to as an interval or dyad.*)
3. A scale composed of all 12 half steps of an octave.
4. A note that is equal in length to two half notes.
9. The speed of a section of a composition, or of a complete composition.
11. A note that is half the length of a quarter note.
12. The notes found within a major or minor scale.
14. A vertical line that divides measures, or bars.
17. The interval of eight diatonic steps or from one note to its nearest note of the same name, 12 half steps away.
